FUND MANAGER COMMENTS

Data in June has increased the likelihood of an interest rate cut. Annual inflation declined from 2.3% in April to 2.0% in May, meeting the Bank of England's (BoE) target, while the Manufacturing Purchasing Managers' Index declined from 51.2 in May to 50.9. The BoE left its Bank Rate unchanged at 5.25% in June, but markets speculate an August cut is likely. In markets, SONIA remained unchanged at 5.20%, the 2-year gilt yield declined from 4.41% to 4.22% and the 5-year gilt yield declined from 4.22% to 4.02%. We bought certificates of deposit and commercial paper from Jyske Bank, First Abu Dhabi Bank, DNB, BNP Paribas, Barclays, Nordea, UBS, OCBC and Erste Bank, among others. We bought floating-rate notes from National Australia Bank, UBS, and ANZ. We bought bonds from KBN and Canada Pension Plan Investment Board. The weighted average maturity of the Fund was 39 days at the end of May and 37 in June.




